What to Expect Post Treatment:

After treatment:

If you experience discomfort, use an over-thecounter pain medication. Blisters form within 24 to 72 hours.

The next few days:

Avoid squeezing, "popping," or scratching any blisters, as they could become infected.

What To Do After Treatment

If scabs form at the treatment sites, try to avoid picking or scratching—removing the scab can increase the risk of scarring.

Wash all treatment sites 24 hours after

Follow Up Appointment #1 NAME:		Avoid creams, lotions, oils, and sunscreen on the treated skin. These products should not be applied for 24 hours or until after washing the affected and treated skin.

Molluscum is highly contagious, making it crucial to collaborate with your doctor to fully eliminate it. It may require three or more visits to ensure that any new bumps are treated effectively. After the initial treatment, the bumps can easily continue to spread to others. To ensure complete recovery, it's wise to schedule follow-up appointments before leaving your doctor's office.
